While you or your child read check their understanding or help them focus by asking key questions.

Here are some examples of the types of questions you **could** ask ranging from simple up to more complex discussion ideas:

- What is that? (pointing to an object)
 - What colour is that?
 - What can you see?
 - Who is that?
 - What can you see that is "red"?
 - Where is the ... ?" (state an object e.g. house, dog, fish etc)
-
- What is happening?
 - What happened?
 - Where are they going?
 - Who is in the picture?
 - What are they doing?
 - Where have they come from?
-
- What do you think will happen next?
 - How are they feeling?
 - Why are they feeling that way?
 - How do you know?
 - Why are they going there?
 - How will they get there?
 - What do you think will happen at the end?

Asking all these questions is a wonderful way to help children understand what they're reading and seeing in the pictures. We do this a lot at school to support the children when they read at school ☺
