Paper Weaving

You will need...

- Different coloured paper



- Scissors

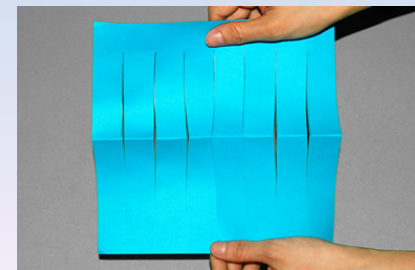
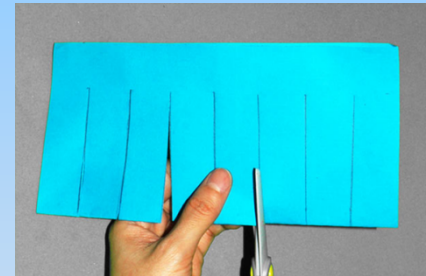
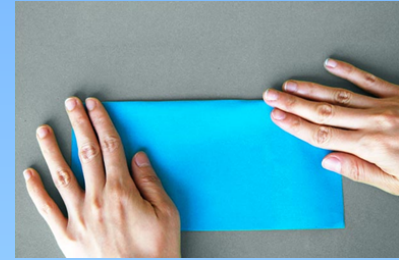


- Glue



Step 1

- Fold your piece of paper in half
- Draw evenly spaced lines stopping 1 inch from the opposite edge and then cut along the lines
- Then carefully unfold the paper



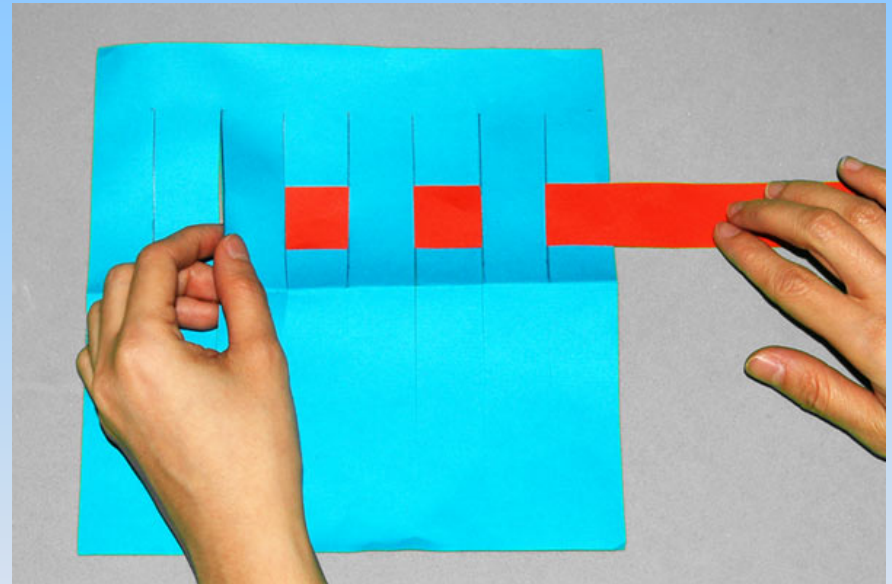
Step 2

- Cut coloured strips of paper.
- Make sure they are longer than the length of you piece of paper.



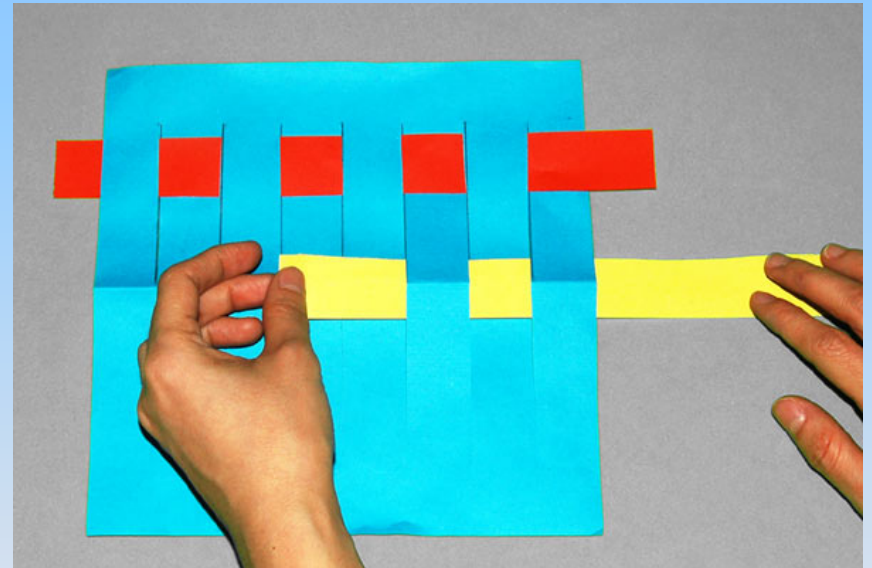
Step 3

- Take a strip of paper and weave it across the slits, going over and under the slits



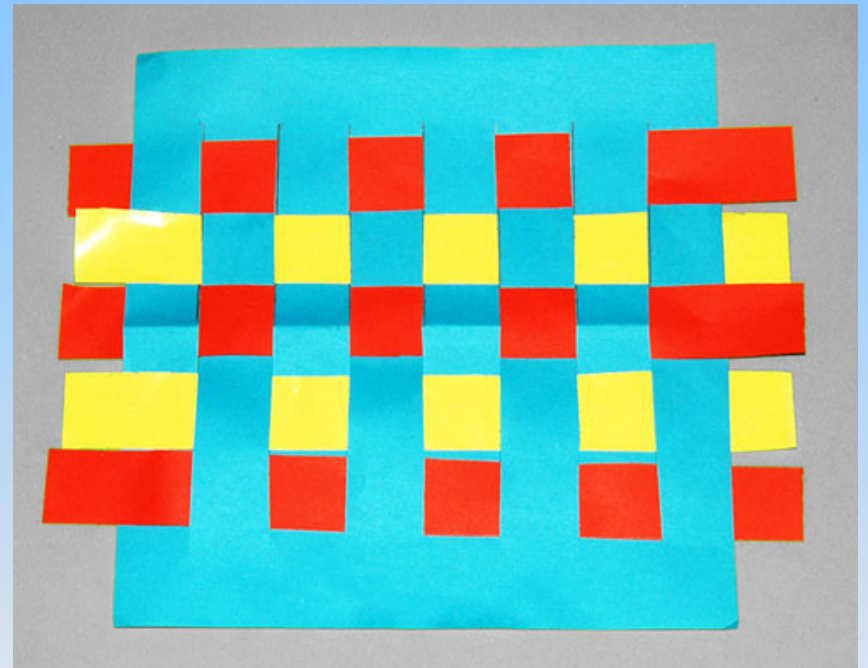
Step 4

- Weave the second strip in an opposite pattern as the first.
- If your first strip went over and under the slits, the second strip should go under and over the slits.



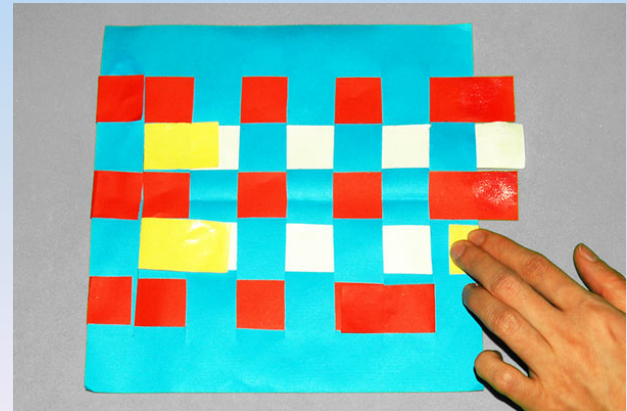
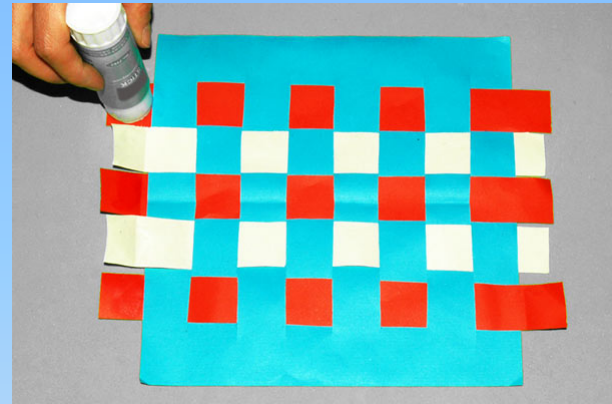
Step 5

- Weave the remaining strips in an alternating pattern until you get to the bottom of the slits and your square or rectangle is full.



Step 6

- Carefully flip the paper square so that the back is now facing up. Apply glue at the ends of each paper strip.
- Fold the ends of each strip over the edges of the paper square or over the slits. Press to glue in place.



Step 7

- Flip the square again.
- Finally, Make a frame to display your work and decorate.
- Be creative and make it your own.
