

# Easter Egg Colour Sorting Game

## Activity Guide

This fun Easter egg game can be used in different ways to encourage children to talk about colours, explore sorting items and practise counting.

One way to play would be to turn all egg cards upside down and spread over a table. Encourage children to take turns to pick a card and sort it into the basket of the matching colour.

Another activity could be an Easter egg hunt! Hide the egg cards around your setting and encourage children to find and sort the eggs into the baskets. They could also count how many eggs of each colour they can find.
