

## Fine / Gross motor activity ideas

	<p>Fine-Motor <b>Treasure Playdough</b></p>  <p><i>One Time Through</i></p>	 <p>PIRATE TREASURE <b>MATHS GAME</b> FOR PRESCHOOLERS</p>	 <p>Can you find the treasure?</p>
<p>Collect the coins. Tape wool zig zagging over the container. Either use tweezers or a spoon and get all of the coins hidden beneath the woolen web.</p>	<p>Hide a range of 'treasures' (random objects) in homemade playdough.</p> <p>See playdough recipe <a href="https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-t-289811-twinkl-s-best-quick-playdough-recipe">https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-t-289811-twinkl-s-best-quick-playdough-recipe</a></p>	<p>Paint an old cold egg box brown to make your own treasure chest. Scrunch up a range of sweet wrappers / painted foil and use tweezers / chopsticks or tongs to collect the treasure to put in your treasure chest.</p>	<p>Hide 'treasure' (this could be a range of toys) in sand or soil. Using a bucket and spade (or appropriate equipment you have at home) dig for each item.</p>

<p>Floating or sinking treasure - Explore a range of pirate 'treasures'. Make a prediction (will the sink or float) then test by putting each item into a bowl / container of water,</p>	<p>More floating or sinking boats themed - Make a foil boat from tin foil. See how many stones / coins etc it takes before your boat sinks</p>	<p>A really fun way to learn about magnetism. Gather together a set of objects and predict which will stick to your magnet?</p>

## Mathematics

 <p><b>PIRATE MATHS</b></p> <p><b>DOUBLING NUMBERS</b></p>	<p>Doubling treasure. With supervision, use a mirror so that they can double how many coins they have e.g. <math>6 + 6</math> (in the mirror) = 12 that means double 6 is 12</p>		<p>Play pop up pirate, if you have it at home.</p>
	<p>Count in 1's, 2's, 5's or 10's, marking numbers either on the ground or on a plank of wood (if you are fortunate to have one). Roll the dice and move towards the sea. The last one left on the plank is the winner.</p>		<p>Treasure maps - Mark out squares on a blank piece of plan or coloured paper. Create islands and treasure on scraps of paper. Using arrows mark the route to get to treasure.</p>

## Art & Design activities



Using sticks collected from the garden or on a local walk or use lolly sticks. Use liquid glue glue them together with a stick (or two) joining them together.



Draw a big pirate ship on the ground outside using chalk (maybe even an island and treasure chest) and roleplay going on a pirate adventure.



Using paper plates, coloured cards and coloured pens / pencils for the pirates features.



Create your own parrot using an empty toilet roll tube, paint / coloured paper, googly eyes and feathers.



Paint the outside of the paper plate brown. Cut out 2 rectangle top parts out of yellow card, 3 boat windows and one flag out of black card. Bend the paper plate in half with the painted side on the outside. Glue the rectangles to the top of the bent paper plate and add the black circles. Add the black sail using a craft stick.
