

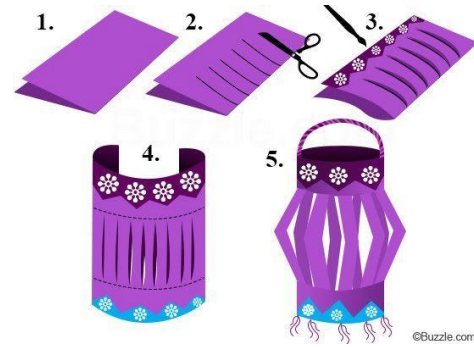
Home Learning Ramadan

Mosque Sponge Painting



- 1) Draw out a silhouette of a mosque on a piece of card.
- 2) Cut out the Mosque silhouette shape (orange card).
- 3) Place the A4 Cut Card over the piece of A4 card / paper (e.g. black) you are going to do your painting on.
- 4) Using a sponge (use a cut up cleaning sponge) dab on the paint to make your mosque painting.
- 5) Using the spare card, cut out a moon shape and a star shape template.
- 6) Using the sponge, paint the moon and stars onto the picture.
- 7) Using either your fingers or brush you can add extra designs onto the picture.

Lantern



1. Get a construction paper (12"x 18") in a solid color and help your kid to fold it into half – lengthwise – in order to get a rectangle.
2. Now using a ruler, draw a 2-inch wide margin along the border of the paper. Now cut equal strips on the paper at 90 degrees with the folded spine. Do not cut through the border.
3. Make colorful designs and motifs with sequins or paints as per your wish on the border.
4. After the decoration has dried, unfold the paper and staple the two top and bottom edges together so that the entire thing looks like a round cylinder.
5. Make a separate strip of paper and staple it to the cylinder to make a handle. Use this lantern to cover bulbs to make them look like colorful, decorative lampshades. You can add tassels on the lower rim of the lantern to make it more festive.

Ramadan Moon and Star Bird Feeders



Thread (hoop) cereal to the pipe cleaners. After the pipe cleaner was full, shape it into a moon or star and close off the end. The final step is to tie off with twine so that the pipe cleaners can be hung from a tree.

Moon and Star Ramadan Craft



- 1) Draw out a crescent moon shape on your paper plate. In the middle of that opening, draw out a star shape.
- 2) Cut out your moon shape and the star shape.
- 3) Paint the star yellow.
- 4) Paint your moon shape blue.
- 5) Glue down your letters.
- 6) Hole punch your paper plate. You'll only need one hole.
- 7) Pull your ribbon through the moon hole punch and tie another knot, so your star won't slip. Enjoy your wall decoration!
