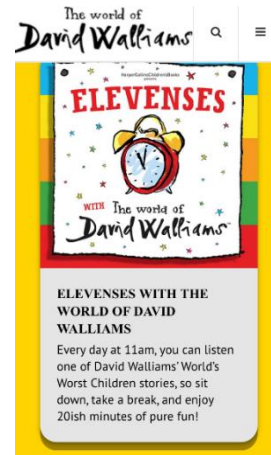

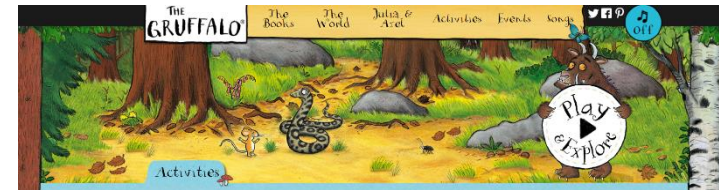

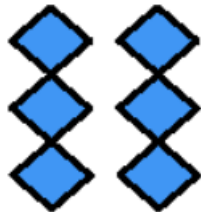

Play matching/sorting games.....

- Put objects on a tray and see if your child can find more of the same object e.g. Spoon, peg, pen, brush, sock etc
- Mix up different colours/sizes of socks for your child to put together.
- Show your child part of a set e.g. *dustpan* and find the object that goes with it e.g. *brush* etc
- Find objects the same colour e.g. yellow- cup, banana, toy duck etc
