Our topic would have been "Water, Water, Everywhere!". Hopefully the sun will come out again because there are so many great ways to play with water in the garden (much less stressful for Mums and Dads too!)

The children could keep a weather diary of what the weather does each day, drawing pictures, writing words or using simple symbols to show how the weather has changed over the week.

If the sun comes out (fingers crossed!), we'd also love to see pictures of the children exploring water in the garden. Explore capacity using cups to fill up a bucket or how many cups in a paddling pool!
