You can Sellotape it to the window and watch it grow 😊

For mark making session you could use vegetables to do some, e.g. potato printing:

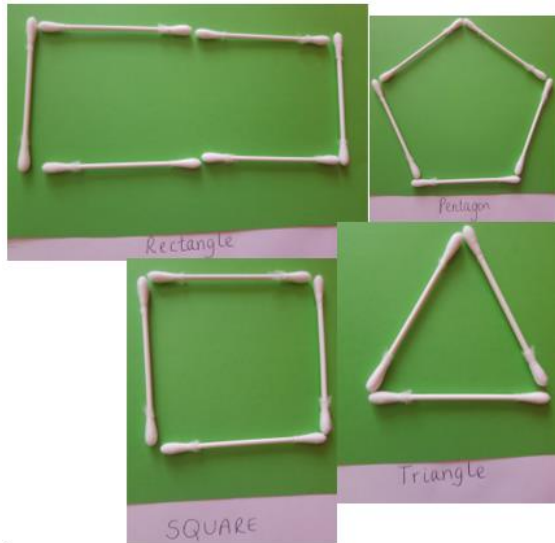


Maths:
