There's lots to see and someone very special waiting at the end!</p> <p>A little girl and her mother board the train in town and set off on a journey through the countryside. As they travel, the girl looks out of the window, asking "What shall I see? What shall I see?" And what does she see? Sheep, cows, horses and much more!</p>	<p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They will continue to use the Read, Write, Inc scheme.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading to an adult several times a week, either books or words from the high frequency list.</p> <p>We will visit the library once a week to look at books.</p>	<p>Cookery</p> <p>Our cookery focus this half term is sandwiches</p> <p>The children will be making some delicious sandwiches with lots of different fillings</p>
