







# Peacock Class curriculum map- Autumn 1

<p><b>Topic</b></p> <p>Our topic this half term is called All about me We will be learning about</p> <p>Week 1- back to school Week 2- likes and dislikes Week 3- friends Week 4- family Week 5- senses Week 6 – senses Week 7 – body parts Week 8 – body parts</p> 	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We will be focusing on:</p> <p>Week 1- back to school Week 2 – number Week 3 – measure Week 4 – geometry Week 5 – number Week 6 – measure Week 7 – geometry Week 8 – number</p> 	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>This half term our English focus is lovely books- We are reading a book The train ride</p>  <p>Climb aboard for a rhythmic train ride through the country. There's lots to see and someone very special waiting at the end!</p> <p>A little girl and her mother board the train in town and set off on a journey through the countryside. As they travel, the girl looks out of the window, asking "What shall I see? What shall I see?" And what does she see? Sheep, cows, horses and much more!</p>	<p><b>Phonics/ Reading</b></p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics. Some children are at the pre phonics stage learning to identify and discriminate between different sounds. The majority of children are now learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They are assessed every half term to see what the next steps are. In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult at least once a week.</p>	<p><b>Cookery</b></p> <p>Our cookery focus this half term is sandwiches The children will be making some delicious sandwiches with lots of different fillings</p>  <p>Week 2 - Jam Week 3 - Soft cheese and cucumber Week 4 - Chocolate spread Week 5 - Egg &amp; Cress Week 6 - Tuna and sweetcorn Week 7 - Marmite</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Each class teaches bespoke science in a fun and practical way. Following themes over the week or half term. These include: Plants, humans, animals &amp; habitats. Materials. Light, electricity, sound and forces. This term linked to our topic we also have real caterpillars in school that we are watching to turn into Butterflies.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>The children will be exploring the topic of emotions. Each week we will be looking at an emotion in detail.</p> <p>Week 1 and 2 – emotions Week 3 – happy Week 4 – sad Week 5 – angry Week 6 – scared Week 7 – anxious Week 8 - jealous</p>	<p>Peacock Class All about Me</p>  <p>Autumn 1 Overview</p>	<p><b>Speech &amp; Language</b></p> <p>We will be having speaking and listening groups which will focus on the children extending their listening skills and being able to take turns and ask each other simple questions and listen to their answers.
