They will be exploring activities that build their confidence and self-belief. They will be using their key mathematics language and embedding this through structured play opportunities.</p>	<p>Cookery In cooking this half term the pupils will be exploring and learning how to use electrical appliances in the kitchen such as kettles, microwaves and ovens. The aim of this is to build their confidence and ability to use cooking equipment independently and safely.
