






Half term overview- Flamingo Class, Leaves Pathway

This is Flamingo Classes curriculum overview for the Autumn 1 Term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school.

Topic	English	Maths	Cookery
<p>This Half Term our Topic is `All About Me`. During this topic the pupils will be learning about themselves.</p> <p>The pupils will be exploring and discovering about their appearances, personalities, their likes/dislikes, their emotions and the special people in their lives.</p> <p>The pupils will be learning about why they are special and unique whilst also being provided with opportunities to grow in confidence in a safe and stimulating environment.</p> <p>At home ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> >Look in mirrors and look at the facial features, can you make silly faces? Or talk about emotions, showing happy and sad expressions? >Making faces with food- pasta etc >Look at family photos can they recognise everyone in their family? >Songs: Head,shoulders, knees and toes song. We have a body. (all on youtube) 	<p>Our story in English this half term is `Peace at Last` by Jill Murphy. The pupils will be learning about the bears featured in the story and will explore the use of adjectives to describe them. They will also be creating their own bear masks and role playing the story.</p> <p>If you would like to listen to the story at home you can watch this video</p>  <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9U9y35kWBvM</p> <p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>The pupils will be developing their phonics` skills in our differentiated groups within the leaves pathway.</p> <p>Due to the current climate pupils will not be taking home home reading books. They will continue to read within school, if you could also read with your child at home this will support their reading and comprehension development.</p>  <p>At home:</p> <p>Reading at home is really important even if a bed time story, a magazine or an article on the internet about a cartoon. It's really good to promote the love of books!</p>	<p>This half term the pupils will be consolidating and developing their knowledge of number, shape and measure. They will be exploring activities that build their confidence and self-belief.</p> <p>They will be working hard to apply their understanding in different engaging learning tasks.</p>  <p>At home ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> >Make a washing line number line >counting crisps for lunch or cereal >Making shape pictures >Spotting shapes in the environment, such as the windows are square, a door is a rectangle etc. >Noticing house numbers or numbers on cars. 	<p>In cooking this half term the pupils will be exploring and learning how to taste test and make toast and its accompaniments.</p> <p>Each week the pupils will taste a range of accompaniments, they will explore their dislikes and likes and then create their chosen dish.</p> <p>Week 1- Toast and spread Week 2- Cheese on Toast Week 3-Spaghetti/ Beans on Toast. Week 4-Eggs on Toast Week 5-Toast Pizza Pockets. Week 6-Toast Houses. Week 7 -Toast faces with fruit.</p>  <p>At home ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> >explore foods they like at home. >can they give a reason as to why they like it? >Can they help making sandwiches or toast when they can practice their spreading skills?
