<p>Topic</p> <p>Our Thematic unit this half term is 'Shine a light and celebrate' which has an RE, Science & History focus. Each week we will be learning about a festival of lights.</p> <p>Week 1- Guy Fawkes Week 2- Shadows Week 3- Diwali Week 4- Torches Week 5- Electricity Week 6- Hanukkah Week 7- Christmas</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be covering number, measure and using and applying on set days each week. In number we are learning to use zero on number lines and with addition and subtraction.</p> 	<p>English</p> <p>This half term our school focus is Traditional Tales. Our story book is Little Red Riding Hood.</p> 	<p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>In phonics this half term, we will continue to split the children into 2 ability groups. Some pupils are remembering sounds and blending them to make words. Other pupils can listen and write words using their knowledge of sounds and groups of sounds.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult at least once a week.</p>	<p>Cookery</p> <p>Shoots cookery focus this half term is pizza with various toppings.</p> <p>Wk1. <p>Computing</p> <p>We will be using our computer sessions for computer based maths and English sessions. We will also be having speaking and listening sessions to encourage pupils to listen to instructions and comment on what we do with objects eg throw or catch or kick a ball.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>Our area of study in PE this half term will be rhythmic gymnastics. The children will learn the skills to move with equipment such as a hoop, ball and ribbon.</p> 
<p>Home work</p> <p>Watch the story of Little Red Riding Hood on you tube and encourage your child to talk about it.</p> <p>Play counting games involving zero eg show a quantity of objects and take them all away – all gone/zero! Play a bingo type game when pupils have to colour the number they hear.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Our science work will link in with our topic learning about physical properties with a focus on light. Try exploring light sources around the home by turning off all the lights and watching them glow.</p>	<p>Trips</p> <p>At the moment this half term we have not planned any trips, due to the covid 19 situation.</p> <p>We do a power walk around the local area once a week.</p>	<p>Important dates</p> <p>15th November - Children in Need</p> <p>Any other dates will be emailed to you either by myself via Blue class or they will appear on RHS website or the school may email.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>We are focusing on keeping our bodies clean, safe and private. Regular washing of hands, not climbing or running where it is not safe to do so and making sure we close the door when we use the toilet or we are getting changed.</p>
