They eat strawberries, watch geese flying, paddle in a stream and finally fall asleep!</p>	<p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They will continue to use the Read, Write, Inc scheme.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading to an adult several times a week, either books or words from the high frequency list.</p> <p>We will visit the library once a week to look at books.</p>	<p>Cookery</p> <p>Our cookery focus this half term is sandwiches</p> <p>The children will be making some delicious sandwiches with lots of different fillings</p> 
<p>Science</p> <p>This half term our focus will be linked to our topic.</p> <p>Week 1 – back to school</p> <p>Week 2 – my face</p> <p>Week 3 – skin, bones and blood</p> <p>Week 4 – human life cycle</p> <p>Week 5 and 6 – senses</p> <p>Week 7 – healthy eating</p> <p>Week 8 - teeth</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>The children will be learning about values and this half term the value is PRIDE. We will be celebrating achievements and showing how proud we are of our pupils.
