







Pearl Class curriculum map- Autumn 1

We will be like Lola trying different foods to see if we like them or not.</p>	<p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics. Some children are at the pre phonics stage learning to identify and discriminate between different sounds. The majority of children are now learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They are assessed every half term to see what the next steps are.
