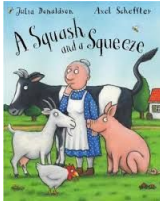


Green Class Curriculum Map Spring 1 2021

Topic Our Thematic unit this half term is 'Art Attack' and we will be looking at the following themes:- • Colour • Drawing • Painting • Printmaking	Maths We will be covering number, measure and using and applying each week. The children will typically have three classroom based lessons and one computer based lesson. These will focus on: counting, capacity, quantities, fast / slow, positional language and finding hidden things, counting coins and role play shopping.	English This half term our school focus is Rhyming books . We are reading 'A Squash and a Squeeze'  We will be using role play and practising our storytelling, sequencing, writing and reading skills in activities linked to the story.	Phonics/ Reading Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They will continue to use the Read, Write, Inc scheme. Pupils will continue to work on individual communication methods in class, such as PECs, colourful semantics and shape coding. In reading the pupils will match / read words and take part in early reading using books, laminated resources, games and the interactive whiteboard.	Cookery Shoots cookery focus this half term is sweet muffins. Computing In Computing we will continue to extend our computer skills, using ICT to support our learning in Topic, English and Maths. Where appropriate we will explore 'photography & editing images', encouraging the children to take photographs and finding the image on the device.	Expressive Arts This half term in Expressive Arts our focus will be Noodle Drumming. Science Science will be taught in a fun and practical way linked to the topic and/or class book, and may include: animals and their young, simple habitats, features of living things, exploring everyday materials, exploring changing materials and colour mixing	Green Class Art Attack  Spring 1 Overview	Speech & Language We will continue to focus on the pupils' communication throughout the school day and have speaking and listening groups. These will focus on extending listening skills,taking turns and asking / answering simple questions.	PE PE is currently led by the class staff. Pupils will be focusing on Rhythmic Gymnastics - attempting a sequence using a variety of equipment. In addition in each class the children will continue to do power walks where possible and daily exercise through dance.
Home work - Share the story 'A Squash and a Squeeze' - Look at real animals or pictures of different farm animals - Enjoying painting -using brushing, fingers or other implements, experimenting with colour mixing - Explore drawing, my turn / your turn to show how to draw - Have fun printing with root vegetables or stampers - Make your own muffins - Explore fast / slow movement themselves and with objects - Investigate capacity / squashing and squeezing using different containers during cooking, bathtime or as a play activity - Explore positional language in, on and under and hide items to find - Join in with 'shopping' as role play or real life. Practice handing over 1p coins for an item	Trips At the moment this half term we have not planned any trips, due to the covid 19 situation. When the situation changes I will contact you with information regarding any future trips. We will continue to do a power walk around the local area when possible, typically as a small group on a Friday afternoon. We will be creating scenarios where the children need to persevere to achieve a final outcome. We will be celebrating achievements and showing how proud we are of our pupils when they show determination. In addition to this there are other bespoke PSHE sessions, following themes such as emotions, families, personal safety / internet safety and independence for life skills.
