

Curriculum overview
Summer 2
Splish, Splash, Splosh!

Please find below the Key stage one curriculum overview for Summer 2 term. The overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school. It also gives you suggestions for activities to support pupils learning at home. These are only suggestions, not compulsory activities.

<u>Literacy</u> This half term children will be reading the story "Silly Suzy Goose!" Pupils will be learning about the different animals in the story, the noises they make and how they move. We will also be making the different animals out of household materials (paper plate lion face for example) as well as mimicking the movement of the different animals in the story. At home: Look at the story online together https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QREqyg_ZRwY	<u>Art</u> Art will be very exciting this half term, we will be doing water based art activities. This will include painting with coloured ice cubes, spraying paint onto paper, filling water balloons with paint. Lots of messy fun. <u>At home:</u> A lovely activity to do at home is to get a water spray bottle and put some watered down paint in it. Tape some paper to out an outside wall and spray the paint onto the paper. 	<u>Science</u> The topic this half term is science based. Pupils will be learning about floating and sinking; change of state; capacity, etc. <u>At Home:</u> The children can play with some toys in the bath, add some everyday household objects and they can see if they float or sink. 	<u>Topic</u> This half term our topic is called "<u>Splish, Splash, Splosh!</u>" The topic curriculum is split into weekly themes: Week 1: Floating and sinking Week 2: Change of state Week 3: Water experiments Week 4: Water experiments Week 5: Water Art Week 6: Water Art Week 7: Water fun! As part of the topic will be visiting a splash park and Grove farm to pick our own strawberries. We will be doing this on the 6th July 
<u>PE</u> In <u>PE</u> this half term pupils will be learning and preparing for the sports day! We will try not to be too competitive	<u>Maths</u> In <u>maths</u> this half term we will be continuing to teach Maths in a personalised and creative way to all of the children. This will include using money, handling and identifying shapes as well as simple counting activities <u>At home:</u> When you are out about and about see what shapes the children can identify in everyday objects and look at door numbers. You can also encourage the children to pay for a few small items with money when you visit a shop.	<u>Cooking</u> During cooking this half-term, we will be making a range of different shortbreads and smoothies. Which I'm sure the children will enjoy. <u>At home:</u> Cut up some soft fruits, mash them and blend them with some milk to make a smoothie. <u>Expressive arts.</u> This half term pupils will be preparing for the East meets West Festival!	<u>PSHE</u> PSHE is a curriculum area of learning that is embedded in all that we do. In addition, this half-term we will be looking at crossing the road safely, as well as more home based things such as washing up <u>At home:</u> Encourage children to help with washing up. When you take your child out encourage them to "stop, look and listen"
