









# Red class curriculum map- Summer 2

Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult on Thursday's and changing their books.</p> 	<p><b>Cookery</b></p> <p>Year 4's cookery focus this half term is Salads! The children will be making some delicious salads using some vegetables from our garden. <p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>This half term our ICT unit will focus on us using Education City and Busythings to support our Maths, English and Science work in class.
