







This is **Pearl** Class's curriculum overview for the Summer 2 term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school. It also gives you suggestions of activities to support pupil's learning at home. These are only suggestions, not compulsory activities.

<p>Topic Our topic this half term is Different Places, Different Lives, which has History, Geography & RE elements. Each week we will be learning about different aspects linked to each countries culture. Week 1- Britain Week 2- Pakistan Week 3- Africa Week 4- East Asia Week 5- Americas Week 6- World Celebration Party</p>	<p>Maths In maths we will continue with the weekly rotation of the following areas: number, geometry (shape), geometry (position and direction) and measure. 'Sam's Snack Shop' will be open every snack time and this half term the children will take turns to be the shopkeeper - really challenging and developing their money counting skills!</p>	<p>English This half term our story is 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We will continue with the weekly rotation of: writing, reading, speaking & listening. We will be doing lots of descriptive writing about the characters and settings. For this we will develop our vocabulary and try to use and spell different (and new) adjectives.</p>	<p>Phonics/ Reading We continue teaching phonics in our differentiated groups within the year band. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters, how to blend sounds to read words and letter formation. All children in Pearl class will complete daily reading.</p>	<p>Cookery This half term we will be making pancakes in different styles and with different fillings.</p> 
<p>Computing This half term our ICT unit will have a maths and english focus.
