








## Half Term Overview - Yr 5/6

*This is Silver Class's curriculum overview for the Summer 2 term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school. It also gives you suggestions of activities to support pupil's learning at home. These are only suggestions, not compulsory activities.*

<p><b>Topic</b></p> <p>Our topic this half term is Different Places, Different Lives, which has History, Geography &amp; RE elements. Each week we will be learning about different aspects linked to each countries culture.</p> <p>Week 1- Britain Week 2- Pakistan Week 3- Africa Week 4- East Asia Week 5- Americas Week 6- World Celebration Party</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We will be spending: 2 weeks on <b>geometry</b> thinking about 2D and 3D shapes and positional language. 2 weeks on <b>measure</b> where the focus <b>will be on weight weighing objects to determine the heaviest and lightest and units of measure for weight.</b> 2 weeks on <b>number</b> with a focus on addition and subtraction, division and multiplication.</p>	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>This term we will focus on the story <i>When Mum turned into a Monster</i> by Joanna Harrison.</p>	<p><b>Phonics/ Reading</b></p> <p>We continue teaching phonics in our differentiated groups within the year band. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters, how to blend sounds to read words and letter formation.</p>	<p><b>Cookery</b></p> <p>This half term we will be making pancakes in different styles and with different fillings.</p> 
<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>This half term our ICT unit will have a maths and english focus.
