This is year 3 curriculum overview for the Spring 1 term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school.

<p>Topic</p> <p>Our topic this half term is: 'Treasure Island' Pupils are to role-play being pirates! Ahoy! They will experience the traditions of pirates such as walking the plank and going on a treasure hunt. Pupils are to experience aspects of science linked to water- floating and sinking. We have six different groups in total. Some children are at the pre phonics stage learning to identify and discriminate between different sounds. The majority of children are now learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They are assessed every half term to see what the next steps are. In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult at least once a week.</p> <p>abc</p>	<p>Cookery</p> <p>Year 3's cookery focus this half term is 'picnic foods'. The skills taught are: chopping, grating, measuring using scales. The main focus is for children to attempt these recipes as much as possible independently.</p> <p>Week 1 - Cheese straws.
