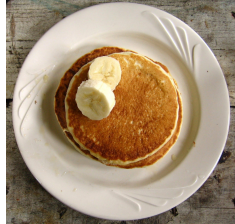
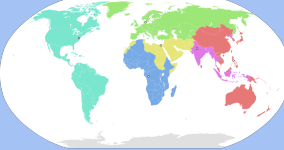


Half Term Overview - Yr 5/6

Topic Our topic this half term is Different Places, Different Lives, which has History, Geography & RE elements. Each week we will be learning about different aspects linked to each countries culture.
