We will be learning about parts of plants, trees and flowers and looking after our school garden. We will be making grass heads and cress shapes. We'll be having a sunflower growing year band competition too! Week 1- What is a garden? Week 2- Growing and plant pot design Week 3- Growing- parts of plants Week 4- Fruit and vegetables Week 5- Experiment- What do plants need to grow?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We're going to have lots of fun with Maths this half term and our focus is going to be on maths in everyday life. So, we will be focussing on: Week 1- Time Week 2- Time Week 3- Money Week 4- Money Week 5- Addition Week 6- Subtraction</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <p>This half term year 4's English focus is lovely books- We have chosen- Jim and the Beanstalk a follow up story from the traditional tale- Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be comparing the texts and focussing on being helpful like Jim is in the story. We will also be thinking about alternative endings, or a third version! We will also be growing our own beans and watching them grow.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Phonics/ Reading</b></p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics in our differentiated groups within the year group. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words.  In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult and sharing a book from a library.  We will visit the library to change our books once a week. We will also be looking at non-fiction texts linked to our topic.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Cookery</b></p> <p>Year 4's cookery focus this half term is Salads! The children will be making some delicious salads using some vegetables from our garden. Lesson 1- Roasted veg pasta salad Lesson 2-Summer cous cous salad Lesson 3- Stir Fry noodle salad Lesson 4- Panzanella Tuscan bread salad Lesson 5- Fruit Salad Lesson 6- Class choice</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>This half term our ICT unit will focus on us using Education City and Busythings to support our Maths, English and Science work in class.
