This year there are five classes in the leaves pathway with children from year two to year six.

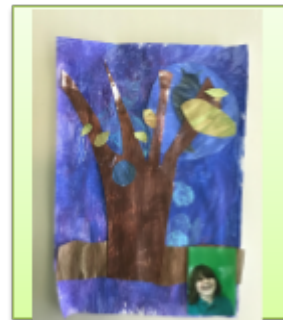
