<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Our topic this half term is Creepy Crawlies</p> <p>Week 1 - CC visit and bug hunt Week 2- CC with 6 legs Week 3 - CC with 6 legs Week 4 - CC with 8 legs or more Week 5- CC with no legs</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Our focus for each week will be:</p> <p>Week 1 - Number Week 2- Number Week 3- Time Week 4- Time Week 5- Geometry</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>This half term year 4's English focus is famous authors- Orange Class will be looking at Julia Donaldson's storybook Rosie's Hat which is all about the adventure a little girl's hat goes on after it is whisked away by a sudden gust of wind.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics in our differentiated groups within the year group. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult and sharing a book from a library. We will also be looking at non-fiction texts linked to our topic.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Cookery</p> <p>Year 4's cookery focus this half term is crumbles! The children will be making some delicious crumbles with different fillings and some vanilla custard to have with it.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>This half term our ICT unit is photography. The children will be learning how to use a camera to take a photograph of something with increased accuracy. They will explore different filters and mashcams and learn how to edit, resize and crop an image. They will build their own photo gallery through uploading, saving and retrieving their work.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Expressive Arts</p> <p>The focus for our expressive arts lessons this half term will be Bollywood.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Orange Class Creepy Crawlies Summer 1 Overview</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Speech & Language</p> <p>In small group sessions we will focus on turn taking and being quiet to listen to others talk so that the children can recall what others have said to them. Another focus will be on speaking to other people about situations such as needing the doctor, calling for a takeaway etc on the telephone.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>This half term in PE the pupils will be focussing on racket sports. The children will develop their hand eye coordination by throwing and catching balls and for some hitting the ball with a racket.</p>
