



## Half term overview- Year 3 Summer 1



<p><b>Topic</b> Pupils are to explore our current Queen &amp; Royal Family. Pupils will be able to create a family tree either of the Royal family or of their own. Week 1 - Number Week 2 - Geometry Week 3 - Measure Week 4 - Number Week 5 - Geometry-</p>	<p><b>English</b> This half term we are stories written by well known authors and all of year 3 are looking at books written by Sue Hendra Bluebird &amp; Swan- Barry the Fish with Fingers Flamingo &amp; Peacock - Supertato Kingfisher - Norman the Slug with a Silly Shell</p>	<p><b>Phonics / Reading</b> From week two we will be teaching phonics in differentiated groups within the year group. Some children are at the pre phonics stage learning to identify and discriminate between different sounds. For follow DfE 'Letters &amp; sounds' for this stage. Some children are learning single letter sounds of letters and how to blend these sounds to read words. Sound children are learning 2 and 3 letter digraphs / trigraphs to blend into sounds to read words. We follow the scheme 'ReadWriteInc'. If you want to know where your child fits please ask the teacher via the home communication books All classes have a timetabled reading sessions where they will read or share a book 1:1 with an adult.</p>	<p><b>Cookery</b> Year 3's cookery this half term is snacks and dips, plus comparing to a bought version Week 1 - Yoghurt &amp; cucumber Week 2 - Houmous Week 3- Salsa Week 4- Guacamole Week 5- Pea mint chilli dip</p>
<p> <b>Computing</b> This half term in ICT the theme is 'Photography and Film.' <b>All children will:</b> use a device to record a sound and take a photograph. They will watch familiar images and videos on screen. <b>Some children will:</b> Use a range of devices to take photographs and record sounds. They will play back their recordings/ view images and identify themselves in images. They will listen to recordings of themselves. <b>Most children will:</b> use a range of devices to take photographs, record sounds, words and actions. <b>A few children will:</b> Will have support to retrieve their work so that they can use a photo editing package to resize, adjust and add design or effects to an image. They will add photographs to a document and add text to accompany their images.</p>	<p><b>Expressive Arts</b> This term is all about <b>Bollywood</b> All children... will be supported to experience Bollywood Music and dance, costuming and traditions.
