<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Topic</b></p> <p>Our topic this half term is Different Places, Different lives. We will focus on RE and geography. We will learn about the following countries: England, Pakistan, China and France. We will be looking at Owl Babies!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Phonics/ Reading</b></p> <p>We will teach phonics in our differentiated groups across year 5. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They will also use the sounds learnt to inform their writing.</p> <p>In reading the pupils will be reading 1:1 with an adult and sharing a book from a library. We will visit the library to change our books once a week. We will also be looking at non-fiction texts linked to our topic!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>In our PSHE lessons we will be working on our school value- Responsibility. Each child will be responsible for a 'job' in the classroom.</p> <p>As a year group we will be mixing the classes for Choosing time on Friday afternoons. This will give the children the opportunity to develop their social skills with children beyond their classroom.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>For computing this half term we will focus on typing and mouse skills. We will be using a 2Simple package called 2Type and mouse skills.
