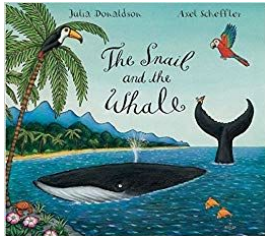


Purple classes curriculum map- Summer 2

This is Purple Classes curriculum overview for the Summer 2 term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school. It also gives you suggestions of activities to support pupils learning at home. These are only suggestions, not compulsory activities.

Topic Our topic this half term is called How Does Your Garden Grow? We will be learning about parts of plants, trees and flowers and looking after our school garden. We will be making grass heads and cress shapes. Week 1- What is a garden? Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. In reading the pupils will be reading to an adult three times a week We will visit the library once a week to look at books. We will also be looking at non-fiction texts linked to our topic.	Cookery Year 4's cookery focus this half term is Salads! The children will be making some delicious salads using some vegetables from our garden. 
Computing This half term our ICT unit will focus on us using Education City and Busythings to support our Maths, English and Science work in class. The children will log onto these programs using their username and password and then access some activities set by myself to further develop their skills.
