| <p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Our topic this half term is Different Places, Different lives. We will focus on RE and geography. We will learn about the following countries: England, Pakistan, China and France. Each week each class will set up their room as one of the countries for the other children to visit, tasting traditional foods, dressing up in traditional costume, learning facts about the country.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Week 1- Position Week 2- shape Week 3- statistics Week 4- capacity Week 5- number Week 6- statistics</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Our unit of study for this half term is lovely books. We are starting with a book called "I'm coming to get you" - all about a scary monster who turns out to not be so scary after all. We are going to use this to link in with PSHE and talking about fears and feelings.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Phonics</p> <p>We will teach phonics in our differentiated groups across year 5. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words. They will also use the sounds learnt to inform their writing.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Cookery</p> <p>This half term our focus in cookery will be: traditional food from the countries in our topic (England, Pakistan, China and France) for the first four weeks and then pancakes nearer the end of term.</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>For computing this half term we will focus on typing and mouse skills. We will be using a 2Simple package called 2Type and mouse skills.
