





This is **SILVER** Class's curriculum overview for the Summer 2 term. This overview gives you a brief explanation of what the pupils will be doing in school. It also gives you suggestions of activities to support pupils learning at home. These are only suggestions, not compulsory activities.

<p>Topic</p> <p>Our topic this half term is 'Fun in the Sun'. We will be learning about keeping safe in the sun. We will have lots of fun doing 'summer' themed activities.</p> <p>Week 1- Introduction to having fun in the sun - wow session Week 2 - Water games Week 3 - Sand play Week 4 - Garden games Week 5 - Walk to the park Week 6 - East meets West</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths we will continue with the following areas on specific days each week: Tues & Thursday- Number Weds- Geometry Fri-Measure.</p> 	<p>English</p> <p>This half term we will be reading the book I WILL NOT EVER NEVER EAT A TOMATO by LAUREN CHILD</p> <p>We will be exploring and re-enacting the story, completing sentences, comprehension tasks, sequencing the story and creating our own pictures of foods that can look like something else!</p>	<p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics in our differentiated groups within the year band. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words.</p> <p>The children will apply their knowledge of phonics throughout the day for all reading and writing activities.</p> <p>The children will continue to read their reading scheme books in class.</p>	<p>Cookery</p> <p>Year 6's cookery focus this half term is themed around going on a picnic. We will be making a range of food and drinks suitable to take on a picnic.</p> 
<p>Computing</p> <p>This half term our ICT unit will be skills based. The children will be making posters, leaflets, cards and invitations.
