| <p>Topic</p> <p>Our topic this half term is 'Great Great Britain'. We will be learning about the cultures and traditions of each country which makes up Great Britain. We will taste traditional food from each country and also practice traditional art.</p>  <p>Week 1- UK Week 2- England Week 3- Scotland Week 4- Northern Ireland Week 5- Wales Week 6- EASTER!</p> | <p>Maths</p> <p>In Number we will be continuing with rote counting and remembering numbers before and after a given number to 30.</p> <p>In Geometry we will be covering prepositions eg in on under etc</p> <p>This half term, Silver class are responsible for running the TUCK SHOP on a friday! So we will also be sorting coins and playing at shopping.</p> | <p>English</p> <p>This half term our school focus is 'stories from different cultures'. Silver class will be reading:" FATOU FETCH THE WATER!"</p> <p>This enables us to compare our own lives / country we live in to that of the girl in the story who lives in Africa.</p> | <p>Phonics/ Reading</p> <p>We will continue to teach phonics in our differentiated groups within the year band. Pupils will be learning the sounds of letters and how to blend sounds to read words.</p> <p>The children will apply their knowledge of phonics throughout the day for all reading and writing.</p> | <p>Cookery</p> <p>Year 6's cookery focus this half term is noodles. We will be making different flavours and will also try to eat them with chopsticks.</p>  |
| <p>Computing</p> <p>This half term our ICT unit is coding. The children will use different programs to practice coding at different levels.</p> | <p>Expressive Arts</p> <p>Expressive arts will be an awesome roleplay experience in Jurassic World with dinosaurs.</p>  | <p>SILVER Class Great, Great Britain</p>  <p>Spring 2 19 Overview</p> | <p>Communication</p> <p>We will continue to encourage pupils to communicate throughout the day using speech, signing and/or symbols.</p> <p>A big focus will be responding to questions with an answer, rather than repeating the question eg Hello and how are you? I'm good thanks/I'm tired etc</p> <p>Also we will be working on remembering terms eg long/short, slow/fast etc</p> | <p>PE</p> <p>This half term in PE Silver class will be focussing on dance.</p> <p>We will continue to go swimming on tuesdays.</p> |
| <p>Home activity ideas...</p> <p>Practice SAFE toileting - closing the door / only coming out of the toilet when fully clothed.</p> <p>Communication- comment on what you are doing (eg washing up) and then encourage your child to say "We are washing up!"</p> <p>Also respond appropriately to questions eg "What is your name?"</p> | <p>Science</p> <p>Our science work will focus on Life Processes.. We will have a different lesson each week consisting of:</p> <p>parts of a plant, the plant life cycle, what happens to a plant under different circumstances (e.g. in the dark), the human life cycle.</p>  | <p>Trips</p> <p>We are hoping to visit the Woodlands coffee shop - another opportunity for the children to familiarise themselves with their future school.</p> <p>We will also make several visits to our buddy class at East site or maybe meet them at a nearby park.</p> | <p>Important dates</p> <p>Thursday 28th February - ENTERPRISE DAY - each class will sell a product.</p> <p>Friday 8th March - World Book Day.</p> <p>Friday 8th March - Comic Relief.</p> <p>Thursday 21st March - year 6 parent 'growing up and changing' coffee morning.</p> | <p>PSHE</p> <p>Pupils will continue to work on their personalised learning program (PLP) targets each week.</p> <p>There will be a strong focus on learning about keeping safe when toileting e.g. making sure they keep their bodies private.</p> |
